

Scrapbooking

Class details: 8 weeks Thursday nights 6:00-8:00

This class is perfect for beginners or a great way to make time to scrap for those who have some experience. At the end of this class you will take home a completed 12-month Calendar Scrapbook. Due to the timing of this class you will use pictures from 2009 for a 2011 Calendar. Each month you will choose pictures from a meaningful memory that took place that month in 2009.

At the end of 2011 when you are done with the calendar you will simply take out the pages of the calendar and put them into any 12x12 Scrapbook. This process can continue each year and become a great way to scrapbook without feeling too busy or overwhelmed by scrapbooking.

Some of the many techniques covered include: cropping, journaling, placement, stamping, distressing, embossing, bling, tips on scrapbook photography, etc., etc.! **Supplies needed:** 12" ruler, pencil, scissors, 12" paper trimmer (portable), fine tip marker or pen (acid free), adhesive (acid free glue stick, tape runner etc.). ******First class bring supplies listed above and 2009 Winter pictures to scrap** (New Years, building snowmen, ice skating, or anything special in Winter 2009). If you do not have pictures from Winter 2009 just bring any winter pictures you want to scrap. Bring as many pictures as you want and we can decide what to use in the class.
