### **Cap and Gown**

### **Senior Class Dues**

### **Graduation Announcements**

Students will be receiving five (5) graduation announcements. Additional announcements may be purchased for \$1.00 each. Call 382-6541 ext. 212 or see Ms. Snell in the Principal's office to order more. The announcements will be in the senior packets that they receive around the first week of May.

The **Tentative Graduation Date** is June 11, 2010. This date will be decided by the School Board around the first week of May. The date is determined by the amount of snow days we have incurred. Seniors must be in school for 175 days. Graduation ceremony is held on the football field. Seating is unlimited, and is bleacher seating only. We recommend bringing lawn chairs if you would prefer not to sit in the bleachers.

All students will receive two(2) tickets to be used only if a decision is made to hold graduation in the high school gymnasium. Tickets will be handed out during the last graduation practice. Last minute announcements will be made on the TEN Network and the Website. The P.A.C. will be open for anyone first come first serve rain or shine.
