Discuss in 250 to 500 words one of the following:

1. Please discuss what you consider your best qualities to be, and describe how your college education will be of assistance to you in sharing these qualities and accomplishments with others.
2. Please describe the reasons that influenced you in selecting your intended field of study.
3. Indicate a person who has had a significant influence on you, and describe that influence.

Notice to scholarship applicants

Before turning in this application make sure your name does not appear on any pages except the first page and that you have supplied all the information requested. Include with your application:

1. Your transcript
2. Required essay
