#### **NHCF Medallion Fund**

**No Deadline**

**January 27, 2012**

#### **Granite State Communications**

**January 30, 2012**

#### **Foundation for Rural Education and Development (FRED)**

*Eligibility:* Candidates must be a customer of Granite State Communications, which serves the following town: Chester, Dunbarton, East Deering, Hillsboro Upper Valley, **Sandown**, Washington, Weare and Windsor. #### **Hood Sportsmanship Scholarship**

**February 1, 2012**

*Eligibility:* High School seniors who participated in a varsity sport and who will be furthering their education by attending a two- or four-year accredited college or university next year. Students must have earned a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher and performed volunteer work in the community to eligible. Students will be asked to write a short essay explaining how they have demonstrated value of sportsmanship both on and off the field. Apply online at Hood.com.

#### **Davidson Fellows Scholarship**

**February 1, 2012**

*Eligibility:* The Davidson Fellows Scholarship awards \$50,000, \$25,000, and \$10,000 scholarships to extraordinary young people, 18 years of age and under, who have compiled a significant piece of work. Application categories are Mathematics, Science, Music, Technology, Philosophy and Outside the Box. Davidson Fellows are honored every year in Washington, DC with Congressional meetings and a special reception. Students should be 18 years old or younger as of October 4<sup>th</sup>, Be a US Citizen, have completed a significant piece of work in one of the submission categories, be able to demonstrate that the work is his/her own creation, and be able to attend, with at least one parent/guardian, the awards reception in Washington DC (Note: Travel and lodging expenses will be paid by the Institute). #### **Scholarship for Military Children Program**

**February 24, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Dependent unmarried children under the age of 23 of active duty personnel, reserve/guard and retired military members, or survivors of service members who died while on active duty or survivors of individuals who died while receiving retired pay from the military may apply for this scholarship. Eligibility will be determined by the DEERS (Defense Enrollment Eligibility Reporting System) database. Applicants should ensure that they, as well as their sponsor, are currently enrolled in the DEERS database and that they

have a current ID card. The deadline of **February 24<sup>th</sup>** is a “**Received By**” deadline, NOT a post-marked by deadline. See application for more details. Applications are available in the Guidance Office.

**American Lebanese Awareness Association Scholarship**

**March 1, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Students must be of Lebanese ancestry, live in the New England Region, and will attend college later this year, or who are currently enrolled in a full-time undergraduate program. Application is available in the Guidance Office.

**The Grand Scholarship**

**March 1, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Each year, the Youth Education Summit (Y.E.S.) participants compete for up to \$30,000 in college scholarship awards. Participants are judged based on their initial application, on-site debates and participation during the week. Multiple students receive scholarships in the first round and total number of students selected dictates how much each student will receive. **Atkinson Women’s Civic Club**

**March 15, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Student can be graduating from any accredited high school, but must be a resident of Atkinson, NH for their senior year. **Timberlane Youth Soccer League**

**March 15, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Students must reside in one of the following towns: Atkinson, Danville, Plaistow or Sandown NH, and must have played Recreational Soccer in the Timberlane Youth Soccer League (TYSL) Program for a minimum of 3 years (which is considered 6 seasons). Student and/or parents must have volunteered within TYSL for minimum of one year, which is considered 2 seasons. Please see application for more information. **Odenza Marketing Group Scholarship**

**March 30, 2012**

**NH Association of Broadcasters Scholarship**

**March 30, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Student must be a NH resident, be enrolled or plan to enroll at an accredited two or four-year school with a major or intention of studying over-the-air broadcasting. The student need not attend school in NH to be eligible. Applications are due no later

than 5:00 PM on Friday, March 30<sup>th</sup>, 2012. Application is available in the Guidance Office.

**VFW's Young American Creative Patriotic Art Contest** **March 31, 2012**

Eligibility: Students must be grades 9-12 and attend school in the same state as the sponsoring Ladies Auxiliary. Home-schooled students are eligible; foreign exchange students are not. Please see application for paper or canvas art rules. Digital art is not accepted.

**Sweet Briar Wyllie Scholarship** **April 1, 2012**

**Region 10** **April 4, 2012**

Eligibility: Students applying must meet at least one of the following requirements: The student is planning to pursue a career in **Human Services**; the student has provided support to an individual(s) with special needs or demonstrate advocacy in the support of disability issues; the students has participated in community and volunteer activities with individual(s) with special needs. Application is available in the Guidance Office. Essay required.

**Sandown Baseball & Softball Association** **April 9, 2012**

Eligibility: Must be a past participant in the Sandown Baseball or Softball League; must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher; must be attending a 2 or 4 year college on a full-time basis for the 2012-2013 year; must be a resident of Sandown, NH; and must submit two letters of recommendation with completed application. Applications are available in the Guidance Office.

**Plaistow Fish & Game Club Scholarship** **April 12, 2012**

Eligibility: A Timberlane graduate planning to attend college in the study of conservation, forestry, fisheries, wildlife, and wildlife management, or other related fields. Applications are available in the Guidance Office.

**Citizens Bank High School Achievement Award** **April 13, 2012**

Eligibility: High school seniors who plan to attend technical school or a two- or four-year college. Apply online at [nhcf.org](http://nhcf.org)

**April 13, 2012**

Eligibility: Hispanic and ethnic minority students who plan to attend a technical school or a two- or four-year college. Apply online at [nhcf.org](http://nhcf.org)

**Statewide Student Aid Program**

**April 13, 2012**

Eligibility: Traditional students (ages 17-23) enrolling in a four-year degree program. Graduate students seeking funding should also use this application. Apply online at [nhcf.org](http://nhcf.org)

**Seacoast Scholars Program**

**April 13, 2012**

Eligibility: High school students who live in one of the 37 NH towns or one of the 5 ME towns in the Piscataqua Region (see below) and plan to attend a college full-time. Apply online at [nhcf.org](http://nhcf.org)

**Dan Ketcham Memorial Scholarship**

**April 15, 2012**

Eligibility: A senior, going to a 4-year college, majoring in a field related to *mathematics, science, computer technology, or education.*

**Frank Kelcourse Service Award**

**April 15, 2012**

Eligibility: Senior should have been active in **service-orientated/volunteer** activities at school and outside of school. Application required including transcript and letter indicating plans for college, your ambitions for the future and your needs.

**Lawrence General Hospital Scholarship**

**April 15, 2012**

Eligibility: Open to senior students who have been accepted to any accredited nursing school program (**RN, AD or BSN**), as an entry level, full-time, student. Application is available in the Guidance Office.

**Student-View Scholarship Program**

**April 22, 2012**

Eligibility: Open to graduating seniors planning to attend college. To be considered for the scholarship, students should log onto [www.student-view.com](http://www.student-view.com) and complete the application survey about colleges.

**Merrimack Valley Hospital Scholarship**

**May 1, 2012**

Eligibility: \$500 scholarship open to graduating seniors in good academic standing enrolling in the medical/healthcare field as a full time student in an accredited college or university. Application is available in the Guidance Office

**Merrimack Valley Hospital Medical Staff Scholarship** **May 1, 2012**

*Eligibility:* \$1000 scholarship open to graduating seniors in good academic standing enrolling in the medical/healthcare field as a full time student in an accredited college or university. Application is available in the Guidance Office

**Stephen Phillips Memorial Scholarship** **May 1, 2012**

*Eligibility:* A renewable, 4-year scholarship to students in financial need who display academic excellence, a demonstrated sense of service to those around them, good character and strong work ethic. Awards are limited to residents of New England only. Applications will be posted on their website [www.phillips-scholarship.com](http://www.phillips-scholarship.com) by mid-January 2012.

**Danielle Gretchen Janco Memorial Scholarship** **May 1, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Student must a high school senior in Rockingham County, born in the State of NH, have demonstrated a commitment to volunteering through community service and helping others, and have completed at least 2 years of dance education during their high school years.

**Plaistow Lions Club** **May 1, 2012**

*Eligibility:* High school senior and **Plaistow** resident, who has been accepted, and will be attending next fall, an accredited college or institution enrolled in a program of study leading to either a 2 or 4 year degree.. Transcript and application required.

**S.O.S. Senior Scholarship** **May 1, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Student must actively be involved in Students of Service (S.O.S), and must be accepted to and planning to attend college after graduation. Essay required. See application for details.

**NH Teachers of Mathematics Scholarship** **May 4, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Students must be graduating from a NH high school or be a NH resident; have been accepted to a fully accredited college or university; and plan to major in mathematics or mathematics education with the intent of becoming a mathematics teacher. Students should apply online at [www.nhmathteachers.org](http://www.nhmathteachers.org)

**Atkinson Garden Club** **May 15, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Senior planning to major in horticulture, landscaping, conservation, forestry, agriculture, ecology, botany, environmental engineering, biology, and related subjects.

**NHCF Adult Student Aid Program** **May 15, August 15, December 15**

*Eligibility:* This program is designed to help students who are returning to school to upgrade their skills for employment or for career advancement, to qualify for a degree program, or to make a career change. This program has particular interest in helping applicants achieve economic independence, and in supporting students whose education and training will lead directly to better employment opportunities. Applicants must be legal residents of NH who are independent students. Students must have applied for all other

**Healthy Lifestyles Scholarship**

**May 30, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Open to currently enrolled high school seniors or first-year college students who are a US citizen, and under the age of 25. Students must answer the following two essay questions: in under 100 words, “why is a healthy lifestyle important in school?” and in under 500 words, describe your career plans, goals and personal ambitions. **Vancouver Restaurant Scholarship**

**May 30, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Student must be between the ages of 15-21 as of the May 30<sup>th</sup> deadline, be a United States or Canada citizen, and be a full time student in 2012 in either High School or a College/University. **Atkinson Academy Scholarship (Present Seniors)**

**May 31, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Open to all TRHS graduating seniors. Application, 2 letters of recommendation, transcript, and essay required. Application is available in the Guidance Office.

**Atkinson Academy Scholarship (Past Seniors)**

**May 31, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Open to all TRHS past graduates. Application required - Letter telling of your present academic year, and transcript available to date of scholastic record since your last application. Application is available in the Guidance Office.

**Avar Press Literary Essay Scholarship Contest**

**May 31, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Open to US and Canadian high school students who are members of the classes 2011 or 2012, including home schoolers. See [www.schoarshipguidance.com](http://www.schoarshipguidance.com)

**NHCF Career Aid for Technical Students (CATS)**

**June 1, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Legal NH resident, dependent student (under age 24), has a HS Diploma or GED, and plans to enroll for at least a half-time course load at an accredited school or program. Student must apply for federal financial aid (when available) and demonstrate financial need.

**Big Dig Scholarships**

**June 1, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Student must currently be in Grade 12 or their first year of college. Please see application for more information. [www.studentsscholarships.org/scholarship.php](http://www.studentsscholarships.org/scholarship.php)

**Man Mac Automatic Scholarship**

**June 15, 2012**

*Eligibility:* Student must be enrolled or expect to be enrolled in an undergraduate program by the Fall of 2012. The school you attend must be located in either Canada or the United States. You must have a GPA of at least 2.75 in your last academic year. **BBG Communications Scholarship**

**June 30, 2012**
